ROSES

Patio roses are simply smaller roses and often bred for their ability to survive in pots or containers.

These days many types of roses are grouped together and called Patio Roses.

The Patio rose is a fairly modern term and in recent years Miniature Roses and Dwarf Roses etc are often referred to as Patio Roses.

They come in a huge range of colours and usually flower throughout the season.

Many of them have a pleasant fragrance but they cannot compare with Hybrid Teas or English Roses.

Although they are often bought to plant in containers they should also be planted in the garden where they give a great show of colour and often do better where they can grow more naturally .

Most problems with roses in pots or containers is usually down to lack of water or food.

PATIO ROSES

ABIGAILE (Tanelaigib)

Patio Rose. 1955. 18ins-2ft

Once of the most delightful patio roses on the market. Bred by Tantau in Germany who breed some superb roses and this one is no exception.

Masses of blooms throughout the summer and well into the autumn or until the first frosts.

The flowers colours vary through silver, pink and deep carmine depending at what stage the bloom is at.

A very beautiful little patio rose which can be grown in a container, or looks pretty stunning en masse in the garden.

Not very tall , so can even be grown successfully in window boxes.

Nice healthy foliage and good disease resistance.

For best results plant in a sunny position and dead head regularly.

Not a powerful perfume but very pleasant.



APRICOT SWEET DREAM (Fryritz)

Patio Rose. 1987. 2ft.

Very striking well formed blooms of soft peachy apricot borne both singly and in small clusters.

A small cushion like bush with dense glossy healthy foliage.

Always seems to be in flower and is ideal for the garden or container.

A grand rose for low edging or borders.

The blooms hold their colour and form well in bad weather.

Has excellent disease resistance.

Strong Sweet Scent.

BABY KATIE

Miniature Rose. 1976. 1ft.

A pretty little rose from the USA with very attractive blooms of pink and cream with a yellow blush in the centre.

Not sold in many nurseries in this country but well known on the show bench as it is a Registered Exhibition Variety.

The foliage is matt green and compliments the blooms perfectly.

Can be grown in the garden or a container.

Plant in full sun and a little TLC will repay the kindness.

A wide variation in colour has been detected to varying climates.

Not a strong perfume but very pleasing.

PATIO ROSES

BENSON & HEDGES SPECIAL (Macshana)

Patio Rose. 1982. 18ins-24ins

Pure gold blooms cover this compact bush throughout the growing season and always seems to be in flower.

The beautifully shaped golden yellow blooms are shown at their best against the light green foliage.

Happy in the garden or a container.

For the best show the spent blooms should be removed at regular intervals.

A lovely little rose that is happy in any position and excellent for cutting.

Scented.

Named for the Benson And Hedges tobacco company.

We may well be breaking the law by advertising this rose, as the laws have changed dramatically since tobacco was described by Robert Burton in the seventeenth century as "a sovereign remedy to all diseases"



BIRTHDAY WISHES. (Poulshrimp)

Patio Rose. 2000. 2ft

An attractive new patio rose with an abundance of orange / red blooms throughout the season. Blooms from late spring until the first frosts.

Semi glossy medium green foliage.

Can be grown in a container or the garden and produces an amazing amount of blooms.

One of the new "Wishes Group" bred by Poulson of Denmark.

A slight but distinct perfume which makes a lovely gift for any birthday.

Also known as 'Shrimp Hit'



BLACK JACK (Minkco)

Miniature Rose. 1983. 1ft-6ins

A tough little rose with plenty of very dark red blooms and attractive golden stamens.

The blooms are quite large for such a small rose and are shaped like miniature hybrid tea blooms.

Looks super planted in a group in the garden or can also be grown in a container.

Bred in the USA.

Recognised Exhibition Variety.

Small dark green foliage, plus a pleasant fragrance.

As with many dark red roses may need a little TLC to get the best results.

Dead head regularly to promote further blooms,



PATIO ROSES

BLUE PETER (Ruiblun)

Miniature Rose. 1983. 12ins-20ins

Lilac purple blooms with contrasting golden stamens make this rose a real talking point in the garden.

The flowers have about 20 petals and last for weeks on the bush. Plenty of blooms right through the summer and well into the autumn.

For the best results dead head regularly to promote further blooms. It is treasured by flower arrangers who love the colour combination and the light green semi glossy foliage.

A compact bush that only grows to about 12-20ins (30-50cm)

An unusual colour rose which is ideal for the garden or a container on the patio.

Something a little different.

Scented.

Also known as 'Bluenette'

Named for the BBC children's TV programme.

CARROT TOP (Poultop)

Patio Rose 1991. 16ins.

An attractive little patio rose with masses of bright red-orange blooms.

This excellent 'Wishes' range always seem to be in flower and have excellent disease resistance.

Plant in full sun for the best results.

Quite at home in the garden or a container and a lovely gift for any Red Head.

Dead head regularly to promote further blooms and to keep the bush tidy.

Scented.

CASCADING WHITE (Dickwhynot)

Patio Rose. 2002. 2ft.

A very pretty little rose with pink buds which mature into lovely white blooms with an attractive yellow eye. Always seems to be in flower whatever the weather.

Makes a wonderful and different gift.

Fragrant.

Can be grown in a container or the garden, or looks great cascading down from a large hanging basket.

For the best results cut down a little after the first flush and the repeat flowers will last the rest of the summer and well into the autumn.

DANNY BOY (Dicxcon)

Patio Rose. 2000. 2ft

A lovely little rose with masses of rusty orange hybrid tea shaped blooms.

Very attractive and flowers right through the season from late spring until the first frosts.

Small semi glossy medium green foliage which has excellent disease resistance.

Plenty of blooms so dead head throughout the season to promote further blooming and keep this nice little rose neat and tidy.

Looks great in a group in the garden or a container.

Bred by Dickson's of Northern Ireland who are breeders of some of the worlds most beautiful roses.

An unusual colour which has made it very popular.

DEB'S DELIGHT (Legsweet)

Patio Rose. 1983. 18ins-2ft.

A really lovely little patio rose.

Colour tones of silvery salmon pink and flowers very freely through summer and autumn.

Plenty of flowers so dead head regularly to promote further blooms and to keep the plant tidy.

Mid green semi glossy foliage.

Ideal for the border in a group or singly in a container.

Remove spent blooms regularly which will encourage speedy re-blooming.

A short bushy rose with small semi-glossy medium green foliage.

Is quite at home in the garden or a container.
